#### **ACADEMIC INFORMATION**

#### **Attendance**

- 01. Regular attendance of the students is compulsory.
- 02. The student should not be absent without producing proper leave letter duly signed by the parent and the class incharge.
- 03. Attendance will not be given to the late comers.
- 04. The Student will be allowed to appear for the University Examinations only if she has atleast 75% of attendance each semester. She will be eligible to get the government scholarship only if she has 90% of attendance.

#### **University Examination**

- 01. The End Semester Examination will be conducted by the University for 75 marks and the remaining 25 marks will be given by the college as Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) by conducting Cycle Tests and Seminars in the College.
- 02. In the case of first year UG & PG Programme a student should compulsorily attend atleast one paper in the first semester University Examination to continue their course.

#### **Cycle Test/Model Examination**

- 01. It is a regular feature in our college to conduct Cycle Tests covering various units of the syllabus during each semester.
- 02. The purpose of the Cycle Test is to make the students keep abreast of the day to day classes and prepare them well for the University Examinations.
- 03. The Cycle Test marks are intimated to the parents and weak students are given special attention.
- 04. The Cycle Test profile should be returned to the class incharge after getting the signature of the parent.

- 05. The student who scores fail mark or absent for the Cycle Test will not be allowed to write the University Examination.
- 06. Slow learners are identified and coaching and remedial classes are arranged for them.

- **01. IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell)**: Quality enhancement is achieved by the efforts taken by IQAC. It takes care of ensure quality infrastructure and teaching learning processes on par with said standards.

#### LIBRARY

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The following procedures are adopted to borrow books from the library.

#### I. LIBRARY TOKEN

- 01. Each library token will enable the borrower to **take one book only.**
- 02. The library token will be given to the borrower when the book is returned.
- 03. The due date will be stamped on the slip pasted on the first page of the book borrowed.

- 04. Extension of time will be permitted for only one time.
- 05. If the book is not returned in due date a fine of 5 /- Rupee per day will be levied from the borrower.
- 06. The out going students are to return their borrower library token at the end of the respective academic year and get the clearance certificate from the Librarian.
- 07. The Course completion certificate shall be issued, only on producing the "No Due" certificate from the Librarian.

#### II LOSS OF BOOKS / BORROWER'S TOKEN

- 01. The loss of Library books or library borrower token should be reported immediately to the **Principal through the HoD** in a written form.
- 02. **Duplicate token** will be issued through the Head of the Department on payment of Rs.50/- per token.
- 03. If any book is lost, the borrower should replace another copy of the same in good condition or she will be required to pay double the cost of the published price of the book.
- 04. All the fine amount should be paid to office and students can collect their respective bills.

# III GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED IN THE LIBRARY

- 01. The users of the Library are strictly instructed to leave all their books. note books and bags outside the library.
- 02. Silence should be strictly observed in the library.
- 03. Reference books are not meant for lending and they should not be taken out of the Library.

- 04. The open access system is followed. Students are not permitted to replace the books in the shelves after the use.
- 05. Current periodicals and Journals will not be issued. Earlier issues of the same will be issued to the staff members and students.
- 06. The borrowers will be held responsible for any lapse, damage and non-return of the books issued.
- 07. Question bank, Back volumes and project notes are also available in the library for student's reference.
- 08. E-resources are available in the form of e-journal, e-books and CD'S
