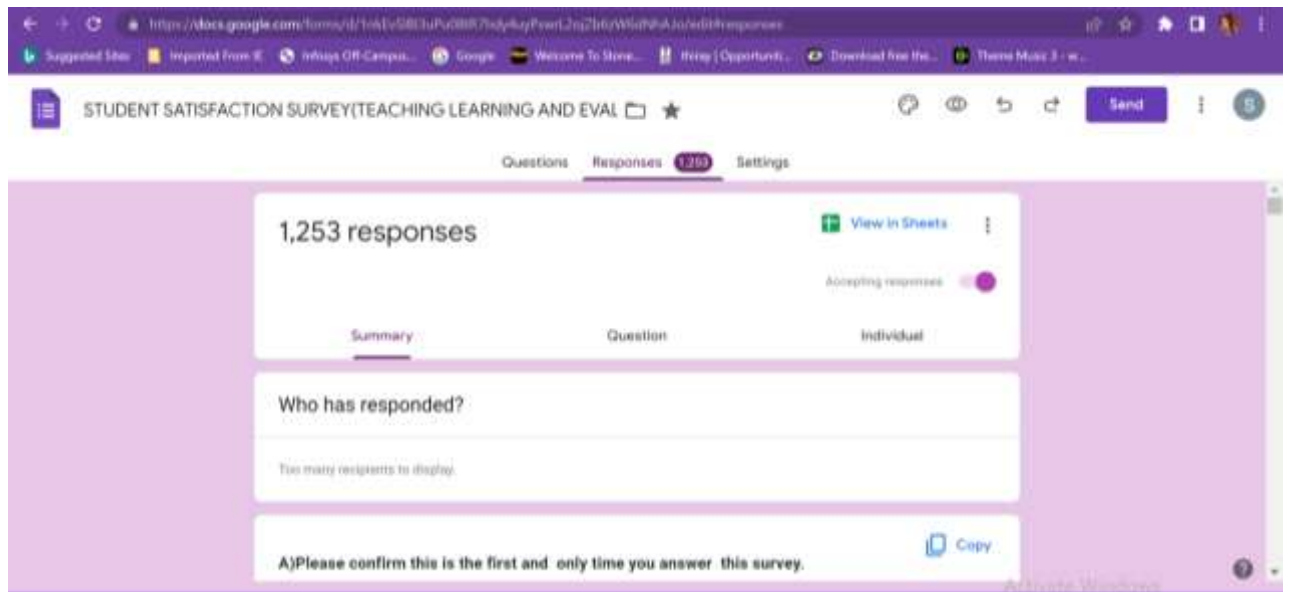


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2.7.1 STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY 2021-2022

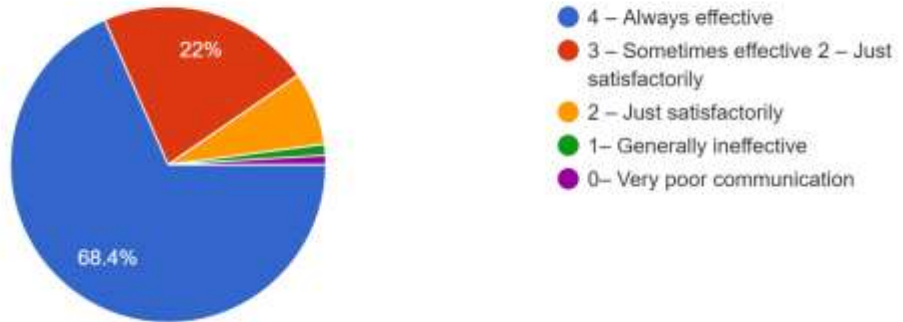


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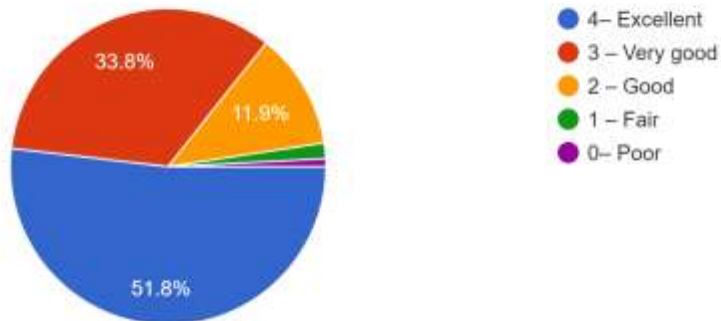
3) How well were the teachers able to communicate?
