

ANNUAL REPORT (2023-2024)

With the blessings of Lord Balavidhya Ganapathi and the presiding deities Alaimagal, Kalaimagal and Malaimagal, we have completed twenty nine years in the field of education. College Annual Day (SUMMIT - 2023) was celebrated in a grand manner. Motivational speaker, Trainer Dr. Soma Valliappan, M.B.A., Ph.D., presided over the function and addressed the gathering.

Our college has enrolled and registered in National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF)2024.UG programmes such as Business Administration and Computer Applications have been applied for approval under AICTE.Professor Tej. P. Singh, SERB distinguished fellow, All India Institute of Medical Sciences,(AIIMS) New Delhi visited our college on 29.01.2024 and interact with our staff members.

Conference Hall and the Computer lab were renovated and inaugurated in the month of November. Newly Constructed Animal house was also inaugurated in November.A well-equipped library is being maintained with 60,084 books and 189 journals and magazines apart from remote access to e-resources.

Students Union Office bearers were inducted in the month of August with P.V. Varsha of III B.Sc., Chemistry as President, P. Charu Chitra of II B.Sc., Nutrition and Dietetics as Vice President, P. In the autonomous end semester examinations for Under Graduate Programmes 37 students have secured first three ranks and in Post Graduate Programmes 40 students have secured first three ranks in their respective discipline. The students those who have secured first rank in the end semester examinations appeared for University Rank Examinations 2023 conducted by Bharathidasan University for affiliated and autonomous colleges and I feel proud to register that our students have secured 24 university ranks. I feel elated to announce that we have secured 100% result in the end semester examinations for UG programmes in the department of English, Business Administration, Commerce, Mathematics, Computer Science, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Nutrition and Dietetics, Physics, Chemistry and Computer Applications. In Post Graduate Programme we have secured hundred percentage result in all the departments.

A sum of Rs. 2, 77,000/- was provided as seed money to the researchers in the academic year 2023-2024. 127 research proposals are submitted to Tamil Nadu State Council for Science and Technology under student project scheme (TNSCST-2023-2024).Totally 52 research articles and 45 Book Chapters have been published during this academic year by the faculty members of English, Bio-chemistry, Computer science, Commerce, Chemistry, Microbiology, Physics and Management studies. Dr. R. Kalaiselvi of Tamil Department published a book under the title 'Pazhamai Enappaduvadhu' which consists of poems celebrating the heritage of life style of village people and agriculture.13 Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs) are signed with various Industries, Educational institutions and

research organizations for the enhancement of research activities and employability skill. Faculty members of all the departments attended 156 Faculty Development Programmes, Short Term Courses and Refresher Courses conducted by various Universities, Higher Education Institutions and Colleges. Dr. S. Manikandaselvi, Department of Biochemistry applied for ICMR proposal and 5 faculty members from the departments of Commerce, Management studies, Economics and Business Administration applied for ICSSR proposal. Proposal to CURIE project was sent by Computer science and Computer Applications departments. CSIR has sanctioned Rs.50,000/- to the department of Physics and Chemistry to conduct National Conference cum workshop on “Determination of three-dimensional structure of small and macromolecules using Single Crystal X- ray Diffraction” from 11.12.2023 to 15.12.2023. DBT-CTEP, New Delhi has sanctioned Rs.2,00,000/- to the department of Biochemistry to organize the International conference on “Structural Biology and Drug Discovery” on 16th and 17th February 2024. Department of Biochemistry and Microbiology has jointly applied proposal to the Indian Council of Medical Research under the title “Exploration of combinatorial therapies on Human Breast Cancer by Inhibiting TGF-beta/SMAD pathway using bioactive compounds of *Ctenopelis garcinii* and Metabolites from Gut Microbiome”. Faculty members of our college attended seminars and conferences as resource persons and chair persons.
