ANNUAL REPORT (2025-2026)

At the outset I extend a warm welcome to the esteemed chief guest, beloved correspondent, renowned guests, staff members, students, parents, patrons, press reporters and I feel elated to present the Annual Report of the academic year 2025-2026, an ex post facto view of our academic activities.

With the blessings of Lord Balavidhya Ganapathi and the presiding deities Alaimagal, Kalaimagal and Malaimagal, we have completed thirty one years in the field of education. College Annual Day (SUMMIT - 2025) was celebrated in a grand manner. Tamil Film Director and Actor K. Bhagyaraj presided over the function and addressed the gathering. A well-equipped library is being maintained with 60,450 books and 216 journals and magazines apart from remote access to e-resources. Commutation routes were extended to interior areas for the convenience of the students. News Letters of all the departments were published through BVG Trust. Academic Audit was conducted for all the departments with subject experts from outside to assess the quality of the departments.

Students Union Office bearers were inducted in the month of August with P. Mahadhi of III B.Sc., Nutrition and Dietetics as President, M. Kamalavarshini of II B.Com., (CA) as Vice President, M. Nidarshana of III B.Sc., Biochemistry as Secretary, S. Swetha of III B.Sc., Physics as N.S.S. Secretary, R. Varsha of III B.A., English as Sports Secretary T. Merlin of III B.Sc., Computer Science as Fine Arts Secretary.

In the autonomous end semester examinations for Under Graduate Programmes 38 students have secured first three ranks and in Post Graduate Programmes 38 students have secured first three ranks in their respective disciplines. The students those who have secured first rank in the end semester examinations appeared for University Rank Examinations 2025 conducted by Bharathidasan University for affiliated and autonomous colleges and I feel delighted to register that our students have secured 11 university ranks in UG and 8 university ranks in PG. I feel elated to announce that we have secured 100% result in the end semester examinations for UG programmes in the department of Economics, English, Business Administration, Commerce, Mathematics, Computer Science, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Nutrition and Dietetics, Physics, Chemistry and Computer Applications. In Post Graduate Programmes we have secured hundred percentage result in Economics, Commerce, Mathematics, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Food Service Management and Dietetics, Physics, Chemistry, Computer Applications and Management Studies.

Under the Government of Tamil Nadu Laptop Scheme, a total of 1085 (532 final year and 553 pre final year) students were benefitted. The Laptops were distributed on 29th January and 28th February 2026.

Independence Day, Republic Day, National Science Day, Indian Constitution Day, Human Rights Day, International Woman's Day, Mathematics Day, Birth and Death Anniversaries of National leaders were celebrated in our college premises. We remain much obliged to our founder Srimathi Krishnaveni Vivekanandam and celebrated our Founder's day on 24.01.26 with Pooja and Bhajan. Onam, Christmas, New Year and Pongal Carnival 2026 were celebrated in a grand manner to bring unanimity among the students. An awareness programme on 'Impact of stray dogs on public health' was conducted on 16.12.2025 to under the link between animal welfare and public health.

'Ilakkiya Virudhu – 2025', with a cash prize of Rs. 1,00,000/- to felicitate eminent writers in Tamil was presented to Writer and Speaker Kalaimamani Dr. R. Kamarasu, Head, Department of Folklore, Tamil University, Thanjavur.

Under the Tamil Nadu Skill Development Corporation (TNSDC) framework, two new training programmes have been introduced in association with Adyar Anandha Bhavan Sweets India Private Limited. The first phase of this partnership is currently underway, with an initial batch of 25 candidates undergoing training in our Skill Training Centre.

Faculty members Ms. T. Vimala, Ms. D. Karthiga, S. Sujatha of Chemistry Department, Ms. P. Punithalakshmi, Ms. R. Manjupargavi, Ms. K. Savima, Ms. N. Subhalakshmi of Computer Science Department, were awarded Doctorate in their respective discipline. Ms. R. Akilandeswari of Computer Science Department have qualified in the UGC – NET examination in June 2025.

Research scholar of Microbiology department Ms. V. Shyamala has successfully completed her Ph.D viva voce examination and was awarded doctorate degree under the guidance of Dr. N. Uma Maheswari, Principal of our college on 03 September 2025. Ms. V. Bharathi, Research scholar, Department of Biochemistry, has successfully completed her Viva Voce examination on 01.09.2025 and awarded doctorate degree under the guidance of Dr. R. Anuradha, Associate Professor and Head in Biochemistry. Research scholar R. Keerthiga of Microbiology have submitted her thesis under the guidance of Dr. M. Kannahi, Associate Professor in Microbiology.

During this academic year, following three patent applications are filed and published. Dr. N. Uma Maheswari, Principal, entitled : A silver nanoparticle-infused mycofilter derived from *Pleurotus florida*

cultivated on agricultural waste. Dr. R. Anuradha, Vice-Principal, titled “CRISPR-Based Precision Gene Editing System for the Treatment of Rare Genetic Disorders.” Dr. B. Kayathiri Bai, Associate Professor of Commerce for the invention titled “The Influence of Social Media Marketing of Herbal Products to Promote Organic Products.” Another three patents are also filed by Dr. G. Manimekalai, Assistant Professor of Microbiology - A chocolate-based delivery system for probiotic microorganisms. Nanotechnology-based dairy products checking device filed by Dr. S. Manikandaselvi, Associate Professor, and Ms. A. M. Thafshila Aafrin, Assistant Professor, Department of Biochemistry. Portable water quality monitoring device filed by Dr. J. Victoria, Associate Professor of Microbiology.

Four faculty members from the Department of Biochemistry, Commerce, Microbiology and Physics participated in a One-Day Seminar on Intellectual Property Rights sponsored under BECH RUSA 2.0, held on 10.10.2025 at Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli. In addition, ten faculty members participated in a virtual Faculty Programme on IPR Management and Technology Transfer in Higher Education, organized by the Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC) and Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) of Sriparasakthi College for Women, Courtallam, on 26.11.2025. The patent application entitled Standardized High-Fiber Polyherbal Nutraceutical Composition for the Management of Non-Alcoholic Fatty Liver Disease (NAFLD) and Constipation was filed through the IPR Cell, marking a proud moment in the College's commitment to translational research and product development. An Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Awareness Programme was conducted on 16th March 2026 in association with the Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Intellectual Property Management under the National Intellectual Property Awareness Mission (NIPAM). 17 Applications submitted to the Tamil Nadu State Council for Science and Technology (TNSCST) under the Innovation and Product Development Scheme.

IQAC plays a vital role in translating institutional vision and mission into measurable outcomes through structured documentation, academic audits, stakeholder feedback analysis, and policy implementation. Faculty members are encouraged to integrate ICT tools, e-content development, and blended learning strategies into classroom teaching. The institution actively promotes enrolment in online learning platforms such as SWAYAM and NPTEL to strengthen digital literacy and subject expertise. As a result of these initiatives, 178 students and 21 faculty members successfully completed NPTEL and MOOC courses during this academic year. Faculty development remains a key focus area under IQAC. Faculty members of various departments participated in Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs), short-term courses, orientation programmes, and refresher courses conducted under the Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Course (MMTTC) organized by various universities. In association with IQAC, the institution organized several academic events such as International and National Conference, National Seminar, National Workshops, Inter-Collegiate Meet were conducted by various departments. IQAC further ensures quality governance through systematic Academic and Administrative Audits (AAA), Mentoring systems, career guidance programmes, entrepreneurship awareness activities, and extension services contribute to the holistic development of students.

The Research and Development cell plays a crucial role in nurturing a research-oriented mind, preparing young minds to contribute to the field of research and development. The Cell assist the faculty members, research scholars, and students to submit research proposals for funding from prestigious agencies such as SERB, CSIR, DBT-CTEP, TNSCST, and SSF. 213 student project proposals were submitted to the TNSCST-2025-2026 scheme. 13 faculty members from the Department of Microbiology, Biochemistry, Nutrition and Dietetics, Computer Science, Commerce, Business Administration, Computer Applications, Physics, Chemistry, Economics and Management Studies have applied for TNSCST research grants. 6 Students of Chemistry, Physics, Computer Science, Computer Applications and Nutrition and Dietetics received research grant under Student Project scheme from TNSCST 2024-2025 and the research report were submitted for the publication in proceedings. To strengthen research activities, sharing knowledge and magnify employability skills, the institution signed 10 Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs) with industries, educational institutions and research organizations for this academic year. 5 Patents were filed and published by the Department of Microbiology, Biochemistry and Computer science. Dr. N. Uma Maheswari, Principal of the college, published a book titled ‘Vermiculture and Vermicomposting: A Comprehensive Guide to Sustainable Soil Management’ through Scientific International Publishing House, Thiruvavur, Tamil Nadu with ISBN. 28 research articles were published by the faculty members of Microbiology, Biochemistry, Chemistry, Commerce, Business Administration, Tamil, English, Management Studies, Nutrition and Dietetics, Physics and Computer Applications in various reputed National and International journals. Three books were published by Department of Microbiology, Computer Science and Computer Applications. 86 book chapters were authored by the staff across various disciplines including Commerce, Chemistry, Microbiology, Nutrition and Dietetics, Business Administration, Computer Applications and English. A five day Professional Development Programme entitled, “The Art of Doing Research: Journey, Writing and

Publications” was organized from 20.05.2025 to 24.05.2025 with Dr. Murugaraj Shanmugam, Director, Tholga Research Consulting Private Limited, Chennai as resource person. Seed money of Rs. 5, 00,000/- was granted to faculty members of Biochemistry, Business Administration, Chemistry, Computer Applications and Management Studies for their innovative research projects in their respective departments for the academic year 2024-2025. Workshop was conducted on Project designing for the UG students on 1st and 7th July 2025 and for the PG students on 22nd and 27th July 2025 with Dr. K. Thiyagesan, Academic advisor of our college as resource person.

The Institution’s Innovation Council has played a significant role in fostering an innovative culture in the institution by encouraging creativity, collaboration, and entrepreneurial thinking among the students community. Through this council various activities were conducted to enhance the norms of the Higher Education Institutions.

Department of Tamil organized a One Day National Conference on ‘Samooga Membattil Pengal’ along with the Women’s Association, Chennai and Paplo printers, Udumalaipettai on 29.08.2025. Faculty members, Research Scholars and Students presented their research findings and the Proceedings of the Conference was released.
